John Guest

- Concerns about the UK and France terrorist attacks.
 - “Soft” targets, on a major London bridge, stabbing of people walking on the bridge.
 - Also Arianna Grande concert in Manchester and a Paris soccer stadium, explosive device outside the arenas.
 - We feel that our level of protection inside an arena is very high but outside an arena is not as high.
- June 14, 2017 tabletop exercise for pipelines hosted by USCG and Colonial Pipeline.
- June 21, 2017, Delaware County, tabletop exercise at Talon Energy Stadium.
- Recently spent some time at FEMA Region III. They are preparing for a hurricane exercise next May.

Larry Bak

- Certification process continues and we are making good progress.
- Very minor responses over the last month. Mixing of ammoniated and chlorinated household products occurred.



Jules DiRocco

- Looking ahead to the 2017 Tier II reporting cycle, SARA III reporting is EPA mandated and OSHA has a Hazard Communication Standard that was revised five years ago. EPA is now catching up to the OSHA standard.
 - Changes to Tier II reporting are mainly related to the adoption of the Globally Harmonized System that is now part of the OSHA HazCom standard. Specifically, the new physical and health hazard classifications.
 - At our September 6th LEPC meeting Jim Harrity from OSHA will put on a presentation on HazCom.
 - At our November LEPC meeting Carol Freeman from PA Department of Labor and Industry will put on a presentation on the reporting changes in PATTS that will go into effect in January 2018. This presentation will be video recorded and posted on our website so those not attending the meeting can get updated at their convenience.
- Our pipeline planning initiative is progressing and a general meeting will be taking place at 1:00 PM today.
- Off-site plans are being updated with 2016 Tier II data and uploaded into Knowledge Center.

- Honeywell facility has a new alarm system.
 - It is a siren and voice system but no email or text capability.
 - Testing will be monthly but a schedule has yet to be established. Once it is established the LEPC will be notified.
- Under new RCRA generator requirements, LQG's are required to send a summary sheet to the LEPC regarding quantities, location, contacts, etc.. Does the Delaware county LEPC have a specific required format?
 - Jules DiRocco responded that we have not yet created any specific requirements but we would be interested in seeing the template that Honeywell has.

- We intend to conduct a tabletop exercise related to the pipeline planning initiative in the fall.
- As we have in the past, this fall we will conduct a hazardous materials conference at the community college. If anyone has suggested topics and/or would be interested in presenting please send let us know.
